“The Management of Contract Claims and Resolution of Disputes” Under the 2017 FIDIC Contracts

OVERVIEW

With all FIDIC contracts there will be claims. This training course is designed to provide practical assistance to those working with the New 2017 FIDIC Contract Conditions in the management of claims and achieving resolution to claims and in particular the workings of the Dispute Avoidance Adjudication Board. (DAAB)

The 2017 FIDIC Contracts are substantially different from their 1999 Contracts when dealing with claims. The new Contracts require the Employer to be treated in the same manner as the Contractor. The Engineer is given greater powers in accessing claims where he is required to act in a “Neutral” manner between the Parties

The dispute resolution requirements are also new with a Dispute Board required to be appointed from the commencement of the Contract and encouragement for the Parties to seek “avoidance” of disputes through a DAAB “opinion”

The World Bank and many other MDB’s have adopted these Contracts
